We would welcome applications from therapists trained and experienced in the administration and reporting of the ADOS and/or ADI-R.

Main responsibilities:

- To provide a high-quality speech and language therapy service to children in clinic and educational settings.
- To assess and diagnose speech, language and communication needs.

- To plan and implement programmes of support and intervention for children with speech, language and communication needs including children with complex learning difficulties. This will include direct work with children and families, group work and collaborative work with other professionals.
